

Piroscafo is a series of components that are either open or supplied with glazed doors in various dimensions. The façade, which consists of glass doors with a frame in steel plate, profiles and columns, comes in tones from the Molteni range, specifically formulated for the product. Plate glass panels in doors are either etched or transparent. Piroascafo can be enriched by the addition of plate glass shelves and interior chests of drawers. The interior can be illuminated with one or more pairs of spotlights, in which case we recommend the shelves in extra clear glass.

Available finishes

Structure, back, door frame: matt lacquer
Shelves: matt lacquer, extra clear glass
Glass of door: transparent glass, etched glass

Materials

Structure and shelves

Veneered panel coated with melaminic paper painted in Molteni shades.

Glass shelf

Extra pale hardened glass thickness 12 mm.

Base

Veneered panel faced with melaminic paper painted various colours, joined to a beehive structure resting on the floor.

Frontal profiles and column

Extruded aluminium profile coated with semi-glossy, oven-fired enamel.

Door

Exterior frame made up of two steel plates, treated with semi-glossy, oven-fired enamel, coupled on a pair of polystyrene shells. Transparent or etched 4 mm plate glass. PVC co-extruded aluminium profile.

Chest of drawers

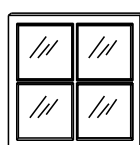
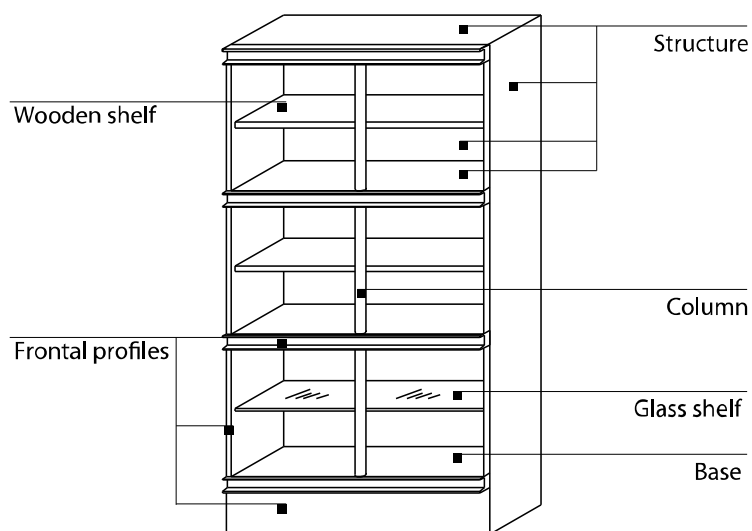
Chipboard panels faced with melaminic paper painted in Molteni tones.

Sides of drawer

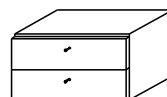
Central plywood support with MDF inside and covered with melamine.

Chest of drawers

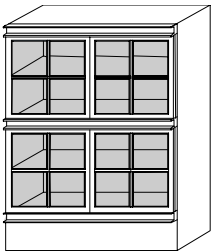

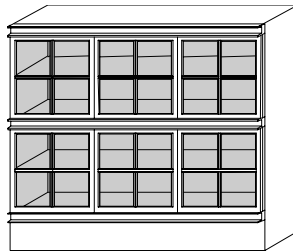

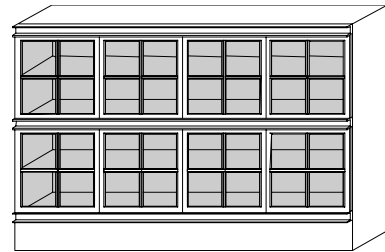

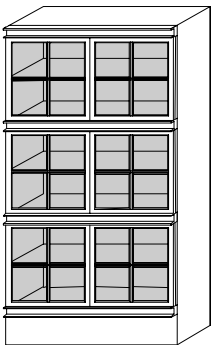

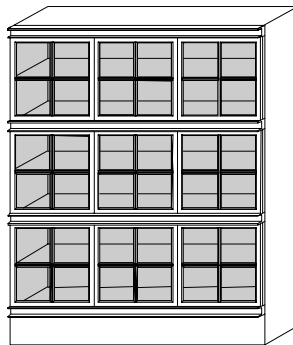
w. 241 – d. 50 – h. 157 cm

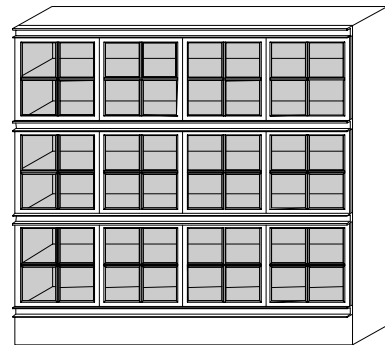
w. 121 – d. 50 – h. 224 cm

Use and maintenance

The product was designed for domestic use for books or other light weights; do not swing on doors; do not climb up on tops. Maximum load-carrying capacity of shelves: 20kg/linear meter, evenly distributed; avoid impacts of all kinds against parts in glass; avoid doing maintenance jobs on components of the product yourself, contacting your retailer if anything goes wrong. When interior chests of drawers are present, do not close doors without shutting drawers first; when you pull out drawers, see that the door is open all the way to avoid breaking the glass and/or frame; keep tops from remaining in contact with water or other liquids, even for brief periods; edges of pieces should never be placed in the vicinity of sources of heat over 45°C. Any odours given off by the product when unpacked are not toxic and disappear when exposed to aired surroundings.

Maintenance of lacquered and glass parts

For ordinary care, use a soft, dry cloth to remove dust. For greasy dirt (fingerprints), we recommend the use of standard glass-cleaning detergents containing ammonia. Avoid products containing solvents and/or spirits and cloths with hard fibres (synthetic/linen) as they could ruin and/or scratch the surfaces.

All these operations should be carried out very carefully to avoid scratching the surface.

Exposure to direct sunlight may alter the colour of the lacquering.

Disposal

Once discarded, neither the product nor its components should be abandoned in unauthorised areas.
