



Rialto is an extendable table with a distinctive personality thanks to the thick top supported by original trapezoid legs. The structure is in wood, the top itself can be in wood or glass paint. Available in wood or with coloured glass top. In the extension versions with glass top, extensions are always in wood.

Internal structure

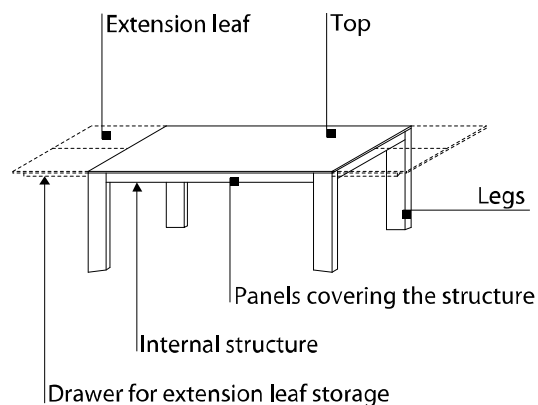
Frame made of extruded aluminium elements and steel plates.

MDF panel faced with wood veneer

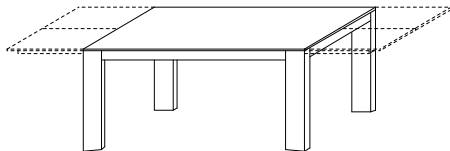
Drawer for extension leaf storage

Frame of solid laminated birchwood with central metal crosspiece.

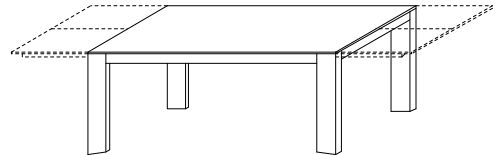

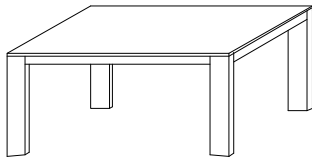

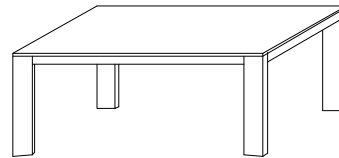

Use and maintenance

The product was designed for domestic use as a top for light weights. Tops of tables are not to be considered work tops of any kind. Do not climb on tables. In the extension configuration do not load up the ends of the table with weights that can cause damage or overturning. Avoid doing maintenance on components of the product yourself, contacting your retailer if anything goes wrong. Keep tops from coming into contact with water or other liquids, even for brief periods of time. Borders should not be placed in the vicinity of sources of heat of over 45°C. Any odours given off by the product when unpacked are not toxic and disappear when exposed to aired surroundings.

Leaf-assembling operations

The table can be extended on one or both sides by pulling out the drawer completely, opening the extension leaves and pushing the drawer inwards to the end stop. The utmost care is necessary during these operations to avoid hand injury or damage to parts of the table. To return to the table's original position, repeat operations in reverse order.

Maintenance of wooden and glass parts

These parts should be cleaned using white spirit diluted with water or products for glass. Dry immediately with a soft cloth. All these operations should be carried out with the greatest of care to avoid scratching the surface. Exposure to direct sunlight may alter the colour.

Disposal

Once discarded, neither the product nor its components should be abandoned in unauthorised areas.
