



Less is a series of metal tables. The four iron legs are L-shaped, with 45mm wings and 8cm thick. A distinctive feature of the table is its very subtle line, counterbalanced by great rigidity, achieved by bending steel plate in accordance with inclined planes. The availability of various sizes and colours offers different uses and possibilities. The classic lacquered version has now been joined by Less Light in shiny aluminium with top insert in wood.

**Top:** lacquered

**Top:** wood

**Legs:** shiny aluminium

## Materials

### Less top

Boxed sheet steel reinforced with segments in bent and ribbed steel plate, held together with epoxy glue and welding. Epoxy paint.

### Less legs

Cold-extruded steel L-bar, 45x45 mm, thickness: 8mm. Epoxy paint.

### Less light top

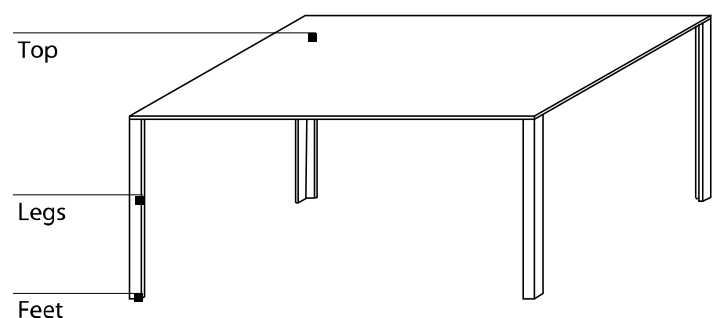
Made of an aluminium sheet bent in a template and anodised, with insert of sliced wood. The sheet is reinforced at the bottom with aluminium ribs attached with epoxy glue. The bottom part of the tabletop is secured with wedges of anodised and bent aluminium assembled with epoxy glue.

### Less light legs

Anodised extruded aluminium.

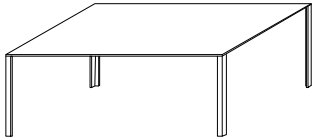
### Feet

Nylon.

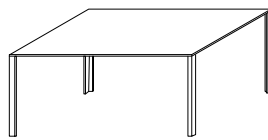

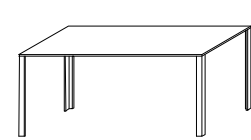
w. 190 – d. 90 – h. 72 cm

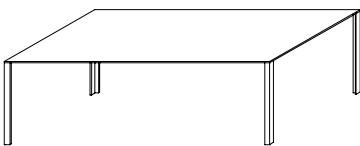
w. 160 – d. 80 – h. 72 cm  
w. 63" – d. 31<sup>1/2</sup>" – h. 28<sup>3/8</sup>"



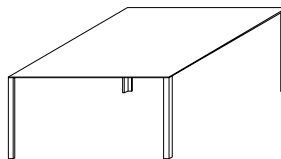
w. 160 – d. 50 – h. 72 cm

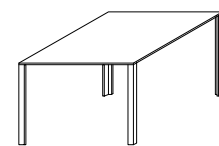
w. 230 – d. 100 – h. 72 cm

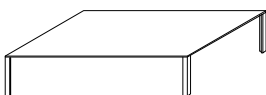
w. 140 – d. 140 – h. 72 cm

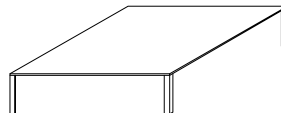
w. 100 – d. 100 – h. 72 cm

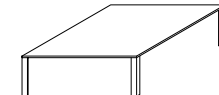

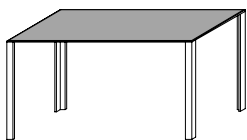


w. 100 – d. 100 – h. 35 cm

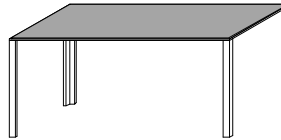

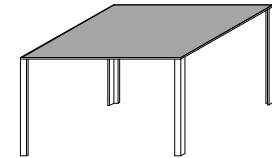
w. 160 – d. 80 – h. 72 cm

## Use and maintenance

The product was designed for domestic use for light weights only. The tops of tables should not be used as work tops of any kind. Do not climb up on the table. Avoid doing maintenance on components of the product yourself, contacting your retailer if anything goes wrong. Keep tops from remaining in contact with water or other liquids, even for brief periods. Never place near heat sources in excess of 45° C or in damp places. Any odours given off by the product when unpacked are not toxic and disappear when exposed to aired surroundings.

### Wood and aluminium parts care

These parts should be cleaned using white spirit diluted with water or products for glass. Dry immediately with a soft cloth. All these operations should be carried out with the greatest of care to avoid scratching the surface. Exposure to direct sunlight may alter the colour.

### Disposal

Once discarded, neither the product nor its components should be abandoned in unauthorised areas.
