



“Hourglass” shaped table, made from two cones with the points joined. The structure, soft-touch lacquered and upholstered in hide-leather or felt, is matched with a shelf in steel available in different finishes.

The top opens into a compartment, so that Buddy can also function as a small container.

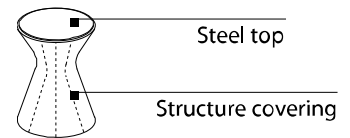

## Use and maintenance

The product was designed for domestic use as a top that can only support lightweight materials. Table tops are not to be used as work tops of any kind. Do not stand on tables and do not sit on them; do not place weights on the ends of tables, as this may damage the table or cause it to capsize. Avoid doing maintenance jobs on the components of products yourself: contact your retailer if anything goes wrong. Keep tops from contact with water or other liquids, even for brief periods. Avoid resting or sliding objects on the surface of aluminium tops. Do not place the table close to sources of heat exceeding 45°C. Any odours that may be given off by the product when unpacked are not toxic and disappear in an aired room.

Access to the container is by lifting the table top. This rests on the structure and is not joined to it in any way.

### Maintenance of chrome or painted metal parts

For everyday care, use a soft, dry cloth to remove dust. For greasy dirt (fingerprints), we recommend the use of standard glass-cleaning detergents containing ammonia. Avoid products containing solvents and/or spirits and cloths with hard fibres (synthetic/linen) as they could ruin and/or scratch the surfaces.

For the shiny chrome finish, treat the surfaces once a month with metal cleaner/polish.
