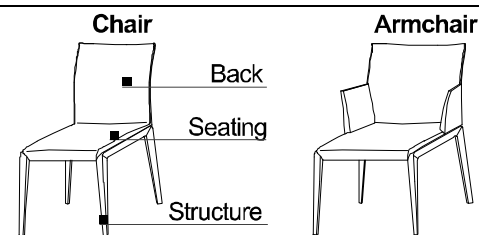
Materials

Upholstered back and seating

Metal framework with elastic straps, padding in flexible polyurethane foam. Cover in double-layer velveteen.

Structure

Polished or varnished pressure die-cast aluminium, with anti-skid plastic supports.

Use and maintenance

The product is designed for domestic use; never stand on chair; avoid doing maintenance on the components of the product yourself: contact your retailer if anything goes wrong. The chair should be used only after you make sure that all four of its legs are resting on the floor. Normal use of the product brings about a flattening in the upholstered parts during the average life of the same. Any odours given off by the product when unpacked are not toxic and disappear in an aired room.

Maintenance - Structure

In order to maintain the aesthetic characteristics of these finishings throughout the course of time and to prevent oxidation, it is necessary to carry out cleaning regularly, methodically and meticulously.

As regards the monthly cleaning of the polished aluminium finishing, treat the surfaces with products specifically for cleaning/polishing metal.
